Thank you for participating in last year's CA State Employees' Food Drive. In 2014-2015, the drive raised a combined donation of canned food and cash totaling 623,488 pounds! An impressive total and an increase over the year prior!

Sacramento Food Bank & Family Services (SFBFS) will be the recipient of your generous donations again this year. Each pound of food donated this holiday season through the State Employees' Food Drive will help to feed the 150,000 of the men, women and children who turn to SFBFS each month. Because of you, fewer families will go hungry in Sacramento County this year.

In addition to food distributions, SFBFS offers nutrition education, gardening classes and school pantry support. SFBFS complements these food bank services by offering a variety of family services including clothing for job interviews, parenting courses, technology workshops, English classes and GED preparation so individuals can complete their journey to self-sufficiency.

All of SFBFS' services are provided at no cost thanks to generous volunteers and donors like you. SFBFS can turn each donated \$1 into \$10 worth of goods and services at no cost. Right now, 245,000 individuals are unsure of where their next meal is coming from. But thanks to you, SFBFS can now reach over 50% of these individuals and help them receive support.


